**ADDENDUM TO THE
MASTER ELITE WEATHER STOPPER ROOFING CONTRACTOR PROGRAM PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT
AND
CERTIFIED CONTRACTOR PROGRAM PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT**

GAF Habitat For Humanity Contractor Program

This Addendum (this "Addendum") is made [REDACTED], 20__ (the "Starting Date"), between Building Materials Corporation of America d/b/a GAF Materials Corporation, a Delaware corporation ("GAF") and [REDACTED], whose address is [REDACTED] ("you" or "Contractor").

1. Effect on Agreement. This Addendum shall become a part of your Master Elite Weather Stopper Roofing Contractor Program Participation Agreement or Certified Contractor Program Participation Agreement, as applicable (the "Agreement"). Except as specifically set forth in this Addendum, the Agreement shall remain unmodified and in full force and effect and is hereby ratified by GAF and you, as amended.
2. Defined Terms. Capitalized terms used but not defined herein shall have the meanings specified in the Agreement.
3. Habitat for Humanity. Contractor agrees to complete the requirements for the Habitat for Humanity Certified Contractor Program, as contained herein. Upon completion of such requirements, Contractor shall receive a certification recognizing it as a GAF Habitat for Humanity Certified Contractor and Contractor shall be recognized on the Contractor Locator on GAF.com as a GAF Habitat for Humanity Certified Contractor. The certification as a GAF Habitat for Humanity Certified Contractor is valid for one year and may be renewed yearly.
4. Contractor Requirements. To qualify as a GAF Habitat for Humanity Certified Contractor, Contractor must contribute two (2) units of labor (as defined below) to local Habitat for Humanity affiliates. One unit of labor equals (a) installing a roofing system on a newly constructed home, (b) re-roofing an existing home, or (c) 40 man hours of non-roofing labor or labor for roofing repairs. Note: a re-roofing job with tear off and replacement equals two (2) units of labor. Contractor may only choose to contribute non-roofing labor toward certification when there are no roofing jobs available.
5. GAF Reimbursement
 - a. GAF shall issue a material credit as reimbursement to Contractor who has contributed his labor and expertise to a qualified Habitat for Humanity roofing installation. GAF shall provide reimbursement for only the following products:
 - Shingles – Timberline Natural Shadow, Timberline HD or Royal Sovereign shingles
 - Roof deck protection – Any GAF residential roof deck protection
 - Leak barriers – Any GAF leak barriers
 - Ventilation – Any Cobra or Master Flow Attic ventilation product at the ridge, to meet local codes.
 - Hip and Ridge Cap– Any GAF Hip and Ridge Cap
 - Starter Strip – Pro-Start starter strips
 - b. Contractor may install other products at its own expense.

- c. GAF is not responsible for and will not reimburse for: (i) re-roofing installations over existing roofing, (ii) delivery of the products, and (iii) any other expenses incurred in connection with the installation, including, but not limited to, the purchase, delivery and cost of all non-GAF roofing materials such as drip edge, nails, flashing, and sealants.
- d. GAF will reimburse Contractor for up to four (4) qualified Habitat for Humanity roofing jobs per year.

6. Roofing Project Requirements

- a. All Habitat for Humanity roofing installations shall use all components of the five-part GAF WeatherStopper system (as detailed in Section 5(a) above).
- b. Contractor is responsible for working with its local Habitat for Humanity chapter in determining who is responsible for tear-offs, disposal and other activities required for a roofing installation.
- c. All projects are to be installed according to local codes and GAF's Pro Field Guide specifications. The installation of leak barrier over the entire roof and double felting are not required and will not be reimbursed by GAF. Failure to follow local codes or the GAF Pro Field Guide may result in loss of reimbursement from GAF.
- d. Contractor shall not re-roof over existing roofing. GAF will not reimburse for such installation.
- e. Any and all roofing projects over thirty (30) squares require pre-approval from GAF's Certified Contractor Program. Call: 888-532-5767 option 3 for authorization.
- f. GAF will provide a System Plus Warranty for each completed installation. Contractor does not have to register this warranty.

7. Enrollment and Administration of Program. Please see Exhibit A for enrollment instructions and other program details.

8. Termination of Program. GAF reserves the right to terminate the program with Habitat for Humanity at any time. Upon such termination, Contractor agrees to cease using the GAF Habitat for Humanity Certified Contractor designation.

9. Counterparts. This Addendum may be executed in two counterparts, each of which shall be an original but both of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

10. Governing Law. This Addendum shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State of New York applicable to agreements made and to be performed entirely within such state.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have duly executed and delivered this Addendum, effective as of the date first above written.

EXHIBIT A

How to Get Started:

- Step 1* **Call and Enroll...** with *GAF Certified Contractor Programs*. We will then contact your local *Habitat For Humanity* chapter and register you. We will email you to let you know you are registered.
- Step 2* **Arrange Your First Project...**by contacting your local *Habitat For Humanity* chapter. You are responsible for working directly with the local chapter and mutually agreeing with the chapter on how you will support them. (e.g., if roofing is needed or not, or if a tear-off is required and how it will be disposed of, etc.).
- Step 3* **Complete Your First Project....** By completing your first project you've shown you are committed to your community. At this time GAF will send you your GAF Habitat for Humanity Contractor certification card. We will also add the GAF Habitat For Humanity logo to your listing on the Contractor Locator area of GAF.com. After completing one project you can use this information to show customers your company is a GAF Habitat For Humanity Contractor.
- Step 4* **Materials and Logistics:** You are responsible for purchasing and bringing all required roofing material to the job site. You will subsequently be given a material credit for GAF designated roofing material by GAF. GAF will only reimburse you for material by means of a material credit.
- Step 5* **Record the Completed Project or Labor Donation...** Once you have completed the project or day of labor please obtain a Habitat For Humanity Job Completion form at the *GAF Certified Contractor Zone* <https://ccz.gaf.com> and fill in all required information. Please e-mail the Habitat For Humanity Job form and job receipts to GAF at ccp@gaf.com or you may mail via USPS @ GAF, 1 Campus Drive, Parsippany, NJ 07054 Attn: CCP.
- Step 6* **Receive Your Recognition And Material Credit...** After receiving and validating your job record, GAF will send you a CD with an electronic copy of a certificate and logo that recognizes your contributions and membership in this program. We will also send you a material credit (within 2 months of receipt of all required information) that you can redeem at a GAF stocking distributor of your choice.
- Step 7* **Keep Supporting The Program...** As noted above, membership of this program requires that you install two new *Habitat For Humanity* roofs, one re-roof, or two days of equal labor per year. GAF Certified Contractors program will send you reminders throughout your first 12 months of membership to complete the full requirements of Certification. Failure to complete the requirements will result in the termination of your Certification.
