Welcome To The Gainesville Facility

"Safety Rules"

1. All visitors, contractors, architects, consultants, building owners and guests must check in at the front desk upon arrival.
2. Any person entering the plant **MUST** wear:
 - Safety glasses (provided at plant)
 - Hard hats (provided at plant)
 - Earplugs (provided at plant)
 - No hooded clothing
 - Closed toed shoes
 - Slacks or full length jeans are recommended for both men and women
 - No high heels
 - We do not require long sleeves in this facility.
3. No tobacco products allowed on premises.
4. At no time will firearms, drugs or weapons of any kind be permitted on the property.
5. No children allowed with plant tour visitors.
6. No cell phone use while the plant tour is in progress.
7. No cameras or photos allowed during plant tour. Plant Manager may review on case by case basis.
8. Accidents and incidents **MUST** be reported to the site HR Department immediately.
9. If you are a guest touring the plant, remain with your tour guide during any fire, tornado or other alarms.

In case of a fire alarm:

Walk calmly to the nearest safe exit and proceed to the parking lot in front of the main office.

In case of a tornado alarm:

The tornado assemble area is in the plant maintenance shop and is identified with the tornado warning sign.
